IBIS Procedures

Background Information

The IBIS/Mondet Access is a resource provided by the Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) for The Partnership staff and its Contractors/subcontractors. The Partnership does not control access and cannot guarantee future access.

IBIS/Mondet resource provides Unemployment Insurance Basic Inquiry and Employee Quarterly Wages from Employers.

An IBIS printout is not required for every applicant or participant.

1. An IBIS printout will be required for:

- All *family members 18 years old and over that are INCLUDED on the "Family Income" screen. Do not list anyone not defined by "Family" under WIOA definition.
- Any applicant 18 years or older with a self-attestation indicating no income or selfemployment.
- Applicants who provide check stub(s) as proof of income and year-to-date amount fails to cover the entire prior six-month period from the application date.
- Any participant 18 years old and over with no income providing a "room and board" letter requires:
 - An applicant statement indicating there is no income.
 - An IBIS report for the applicant.
 - The applicant is considered a family of one.

2. An IBIS will not be required for anyone who falls into the following categories:

- Food Stamps (SNAP) recipient
- TANF recipient
- Homelessness as defined by the McKinney Homeless Assistance Act. Applicant should provide a written self-attestation stating they are homeless and temporarily residing with that person. No IBIS printout is necessary.
- Foster Child
- SSI recipient
- 5% Window (youth)
- Self-Reported Income Attestation (not allowable for income eligibility or priority of service determination)
- 3. Please note: All youth 17 years of age and younger are required to prove parent's or guardian's income. If a parent claims no income, an IBIS printout is required.
- * Family Members are two or more persons related by blood, marriage, or decree of court, who are living in a single residence, and are included in one or more of the following categories:
- (A) A married couple and dependent children.
- (B) A parent or guardian and dependent children.
- (C) A married couple.

Access to IBIS

Access to IBIS requires approval from supervisor/management staff within your organization. The link has forms and information for requesting staff access. https://workforceboard.zendesk.com/hc/en-us/articles/4422393684109-Staff-Data-System-Access-Request-Instructions-Forms The forms contain separate sections, **not all are applicable** read the form thoroughly prior to completing. Submit completed forms to helpdesk@chicookworks.org or your Program Coordinator for processing.

Note: The Digital ID Username and Password must be created via the instructions under the PKI Digital ID Instructions.

Once access is granted you will receive an email with your MHD number, a temporary password, and instructions on creating a password. Read instructions carefully prior to creating your password.

Upon successfully creating your password follow the procedure below to open the system in Edge.

Prior to instructions Microsoft Edge (Windows 11) must be downloaded onto your computer.



To Access IBIS through Microsoft "Edge." (1) Click on the three dots on the upper right of the Edge browser, (2) select "settings" near the bottom of the options, (3) select "Default Browser" and set internet Explorer compatibility options as shown below, (4) Note you will need to add site that you want to use Internet Explorer option for, also note they are limited so you may need to update the time limit as needed. On the Bottom Screen print is what the browser will look like once you make these settings. Note the small "internet explorer logo" on the upper right.



To get there, click the three dots ..., on the far right of the Screen on the EDGE's main page, then scroll down to "Settings", the same way you got to set the Default Browser Settings above. Then scroll down to "Cookies and Site permissions" and click on it, that will bring up a list of additional settings options, scroll down until you see "Popups and Redirects, then you will need to add the URL for IBIS, which is https://services.illinois.gov. once you add that options, close out of the browser, then when you reopen it you should be able to Access IBIS, via Microsoft EDGE.







If Set-Up is correct screen should look like this. Refer to the procedure's troubleshooting section if screen is different.




Upon successful authentication you will be presented with IBIS staff application logon screen. This is where you enter the RACF ID (MHD#) and password.







2. Once UI screen is open enter claimants SSN and select display. Print copy.









1. If searching for quarterly wages select Claims than Pseudo Monetary Information.

3. Select the employer and than click select for additional employer information.









