

- Ask Program Coordinators for Help!



Performance Tips



- Enter Supplemental Employment information!- Current Issue with the System.
- Credential Attainment is record keeping! Collect credentials at completion of training! Have system in place to follow up with people post exit. Contact training providers!
- Review denominator pool! The time frames are different for each measure so need to check who is in the pool.
- MSG is record keeping. People are in multiple years. All in School youth are in MSG. All Career Pathway Training participants in measure. Need a gain each year with active training service.
- Remember Measurable Skills Gain is a live measure-close out completed training services- show gain by 6/30/24

- According to current Labor Market Research, TDL is number one of the top 5 sectors employing the most workers in Illinois at approximately 1.2 million.
- Trade, Transportation and Utilities posted the **second** largest decline in numbers of jobs lost in the state.
