**I. PURPOSE**

This is the transmittal of the revised income guidelines tables. The tables are used to determine the status of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) income eligibility.

The WIOA Policy on Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) contains information to be used to determine the status of WIOA income eligibility. This is commonly referred to as the 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL).

To determine needs-related payments (NRP), refer to the WIOA Policy on Poverty Guidelines for Determining Amounts of Needs-Related Payments (July 27, 2007) and the current WIOA Notice for

revised tables, which are available in the [WIOA ePolicy](#) Manual on the Illinois workNet website.

**IV. COMPONENTS**

Effective for applications taken on or after May 3, 2024, the attached income guidelines for determining low-income status, commonly referred to as the 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL), are to be used to determine eligibility.

**V. ACTION REQUIRED**

The attached tables should be disseminated immediately to all entities responsible for determining eligibility. This notice's attachments should replace those found in WIOA Notice No. 22-NOT-01.


