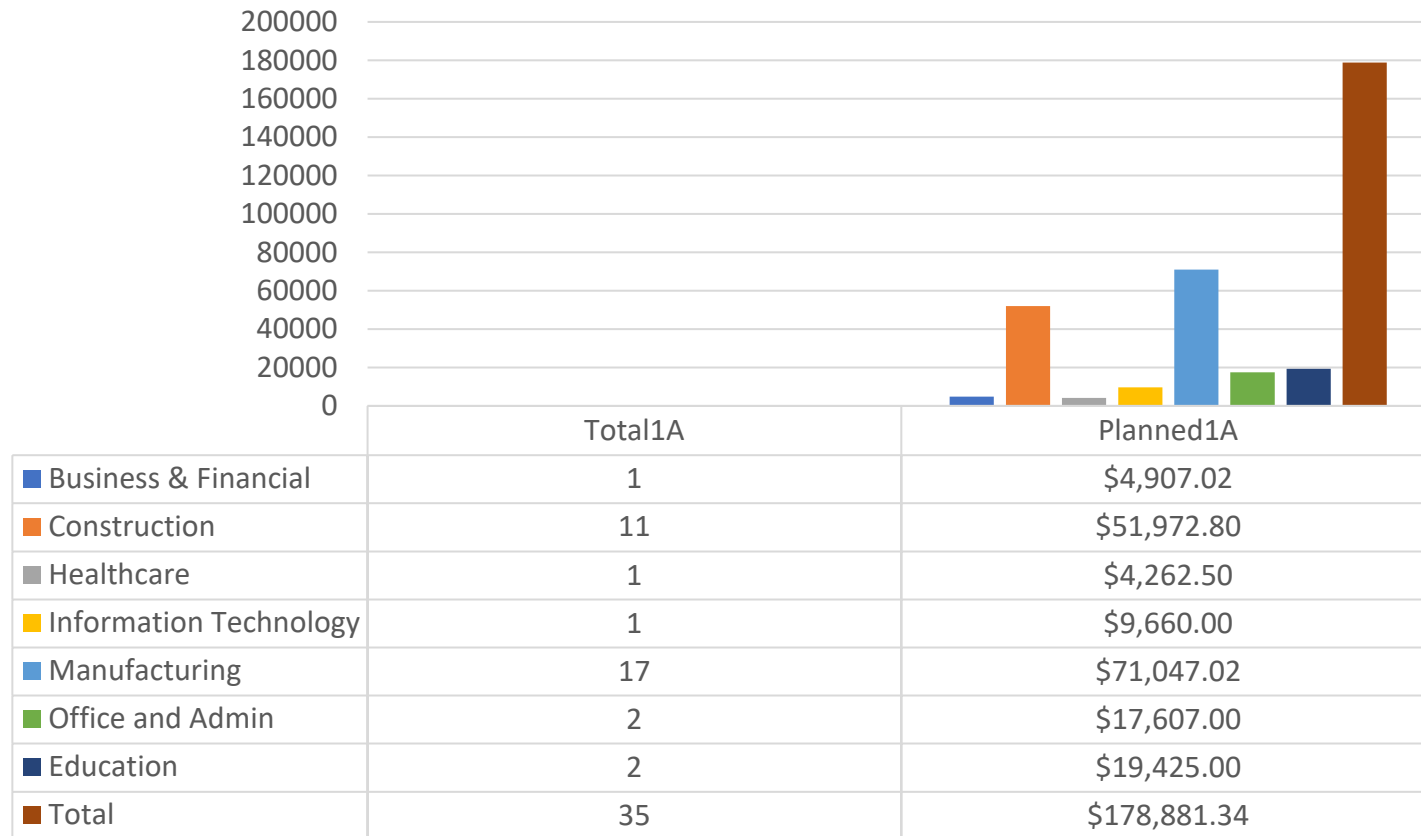

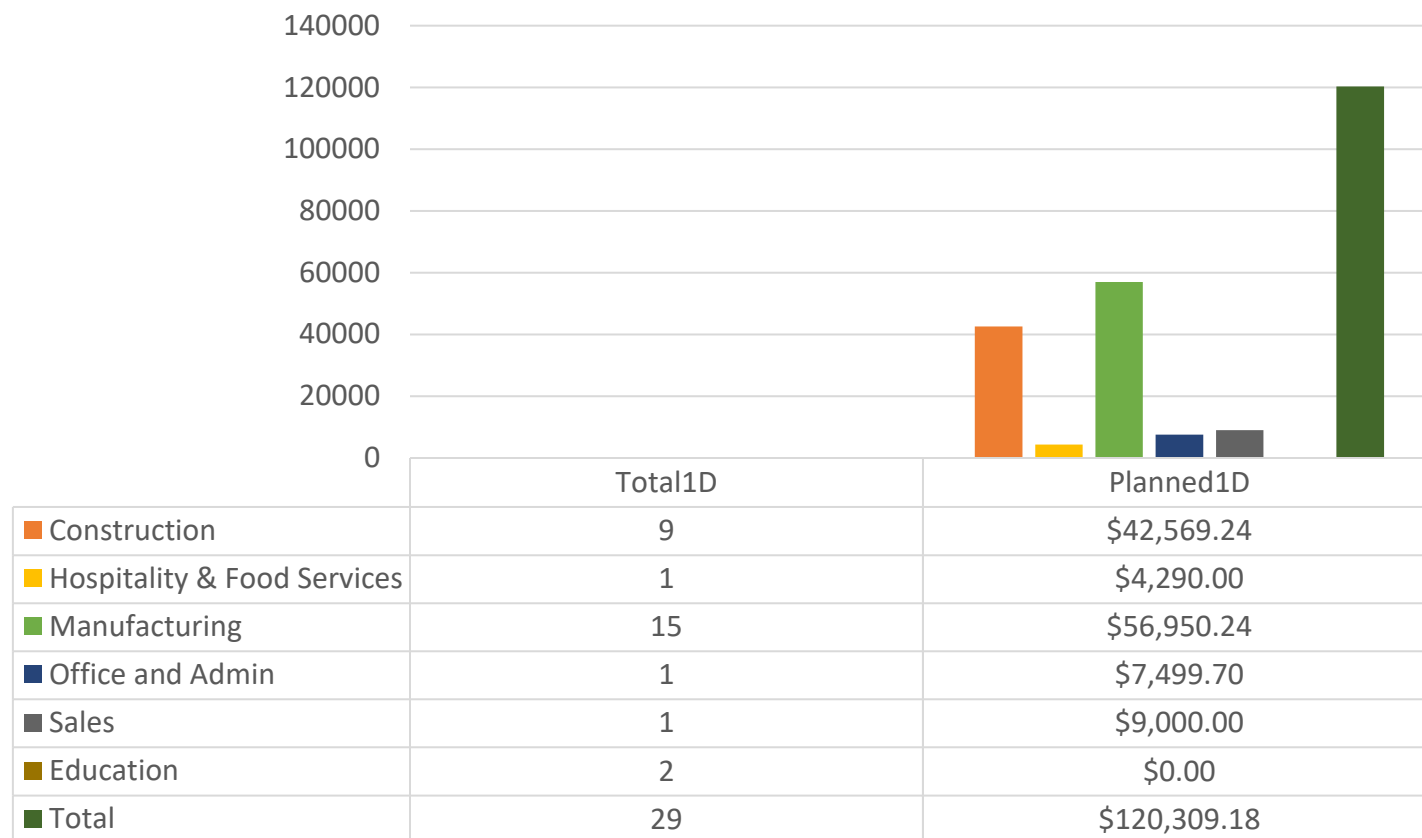

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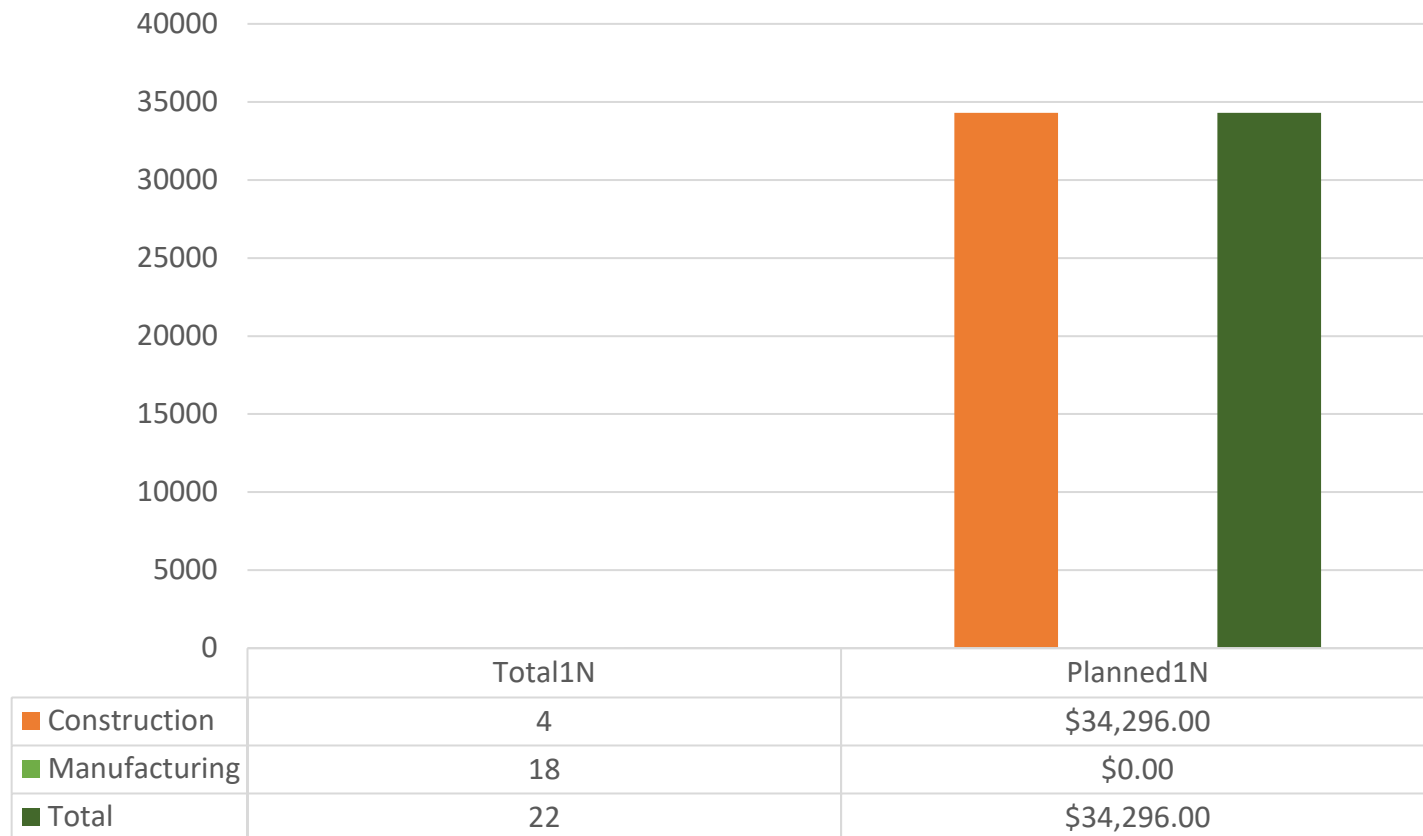
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On-the-Job Training- Dislocated Worker



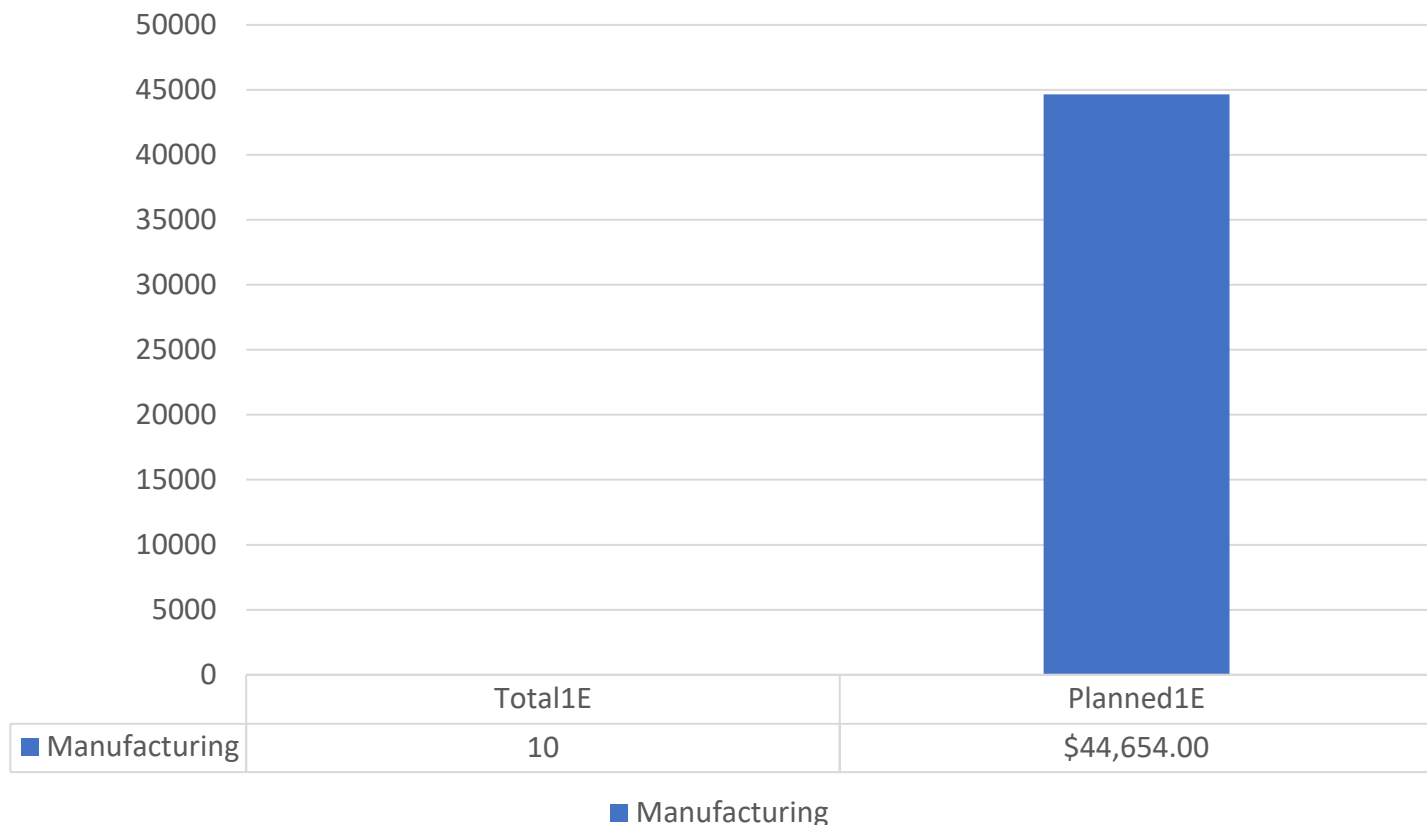

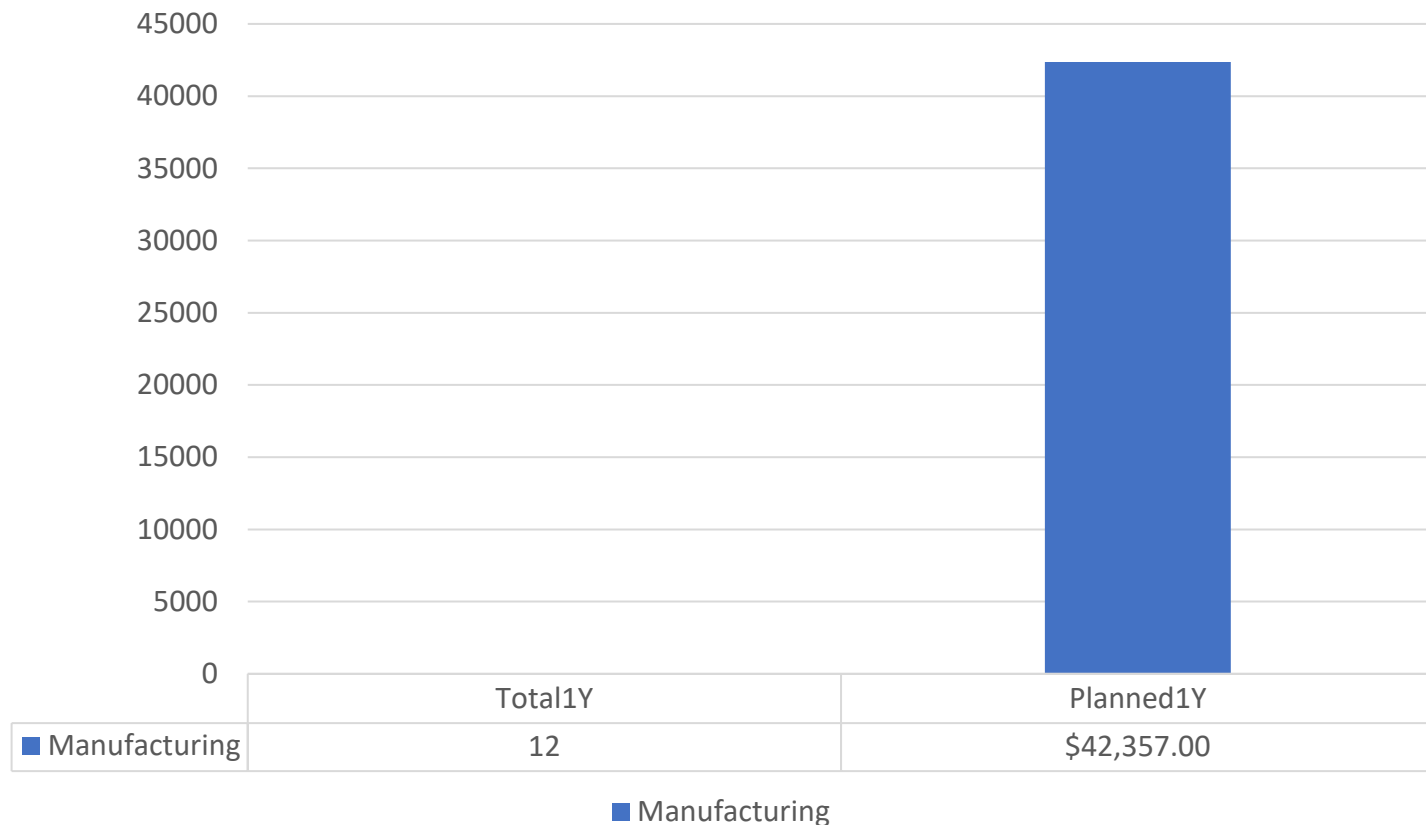

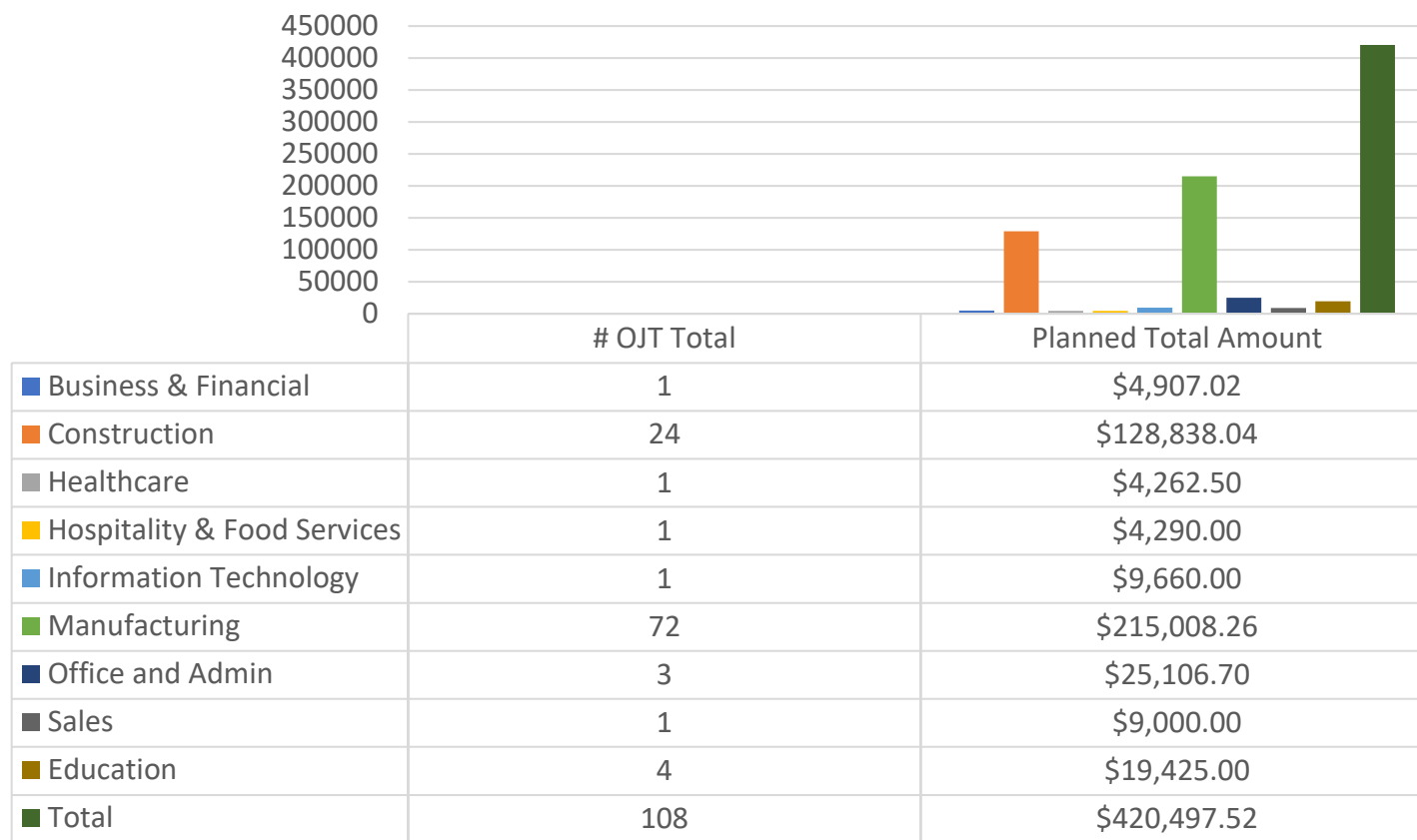

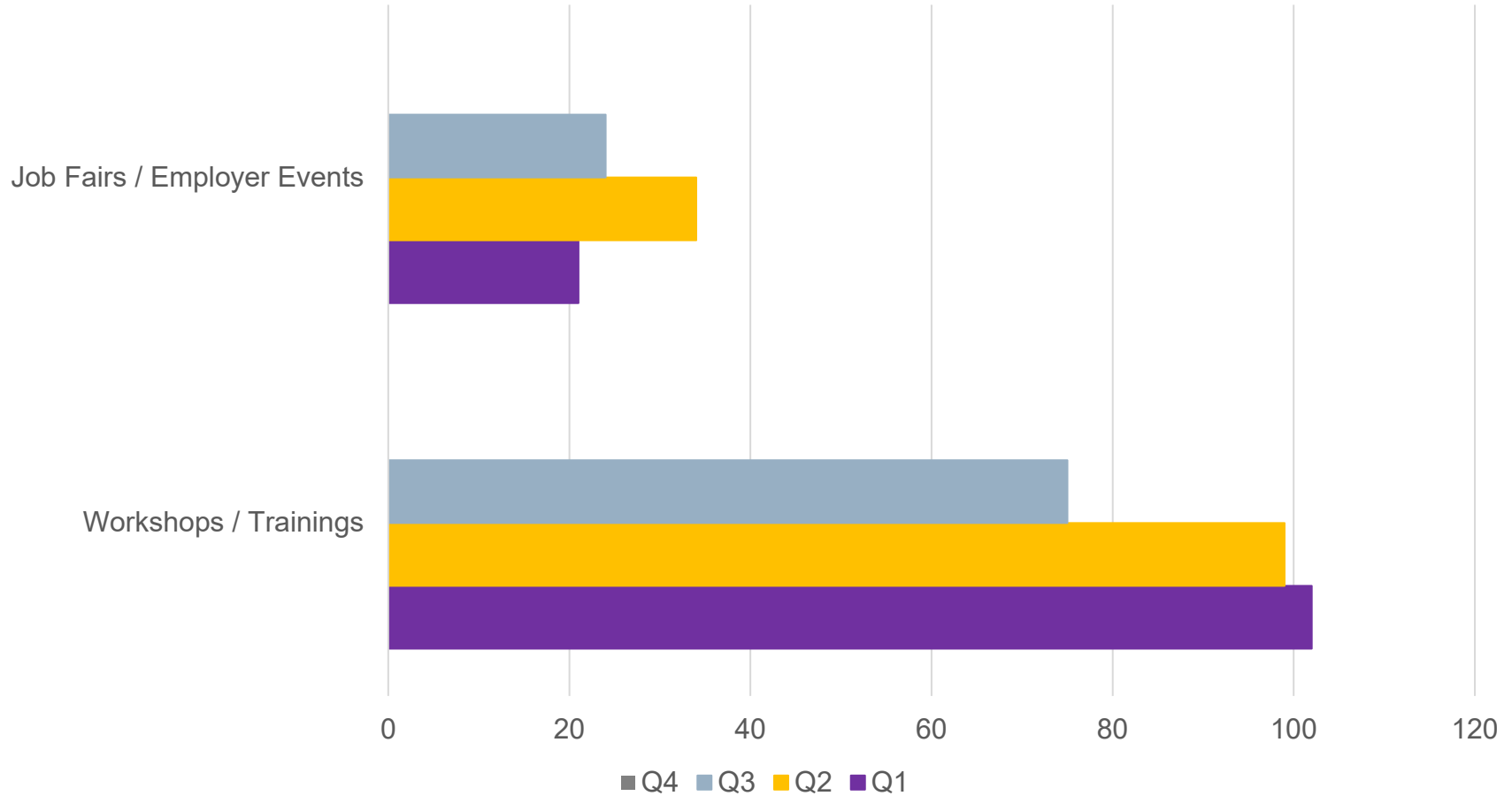

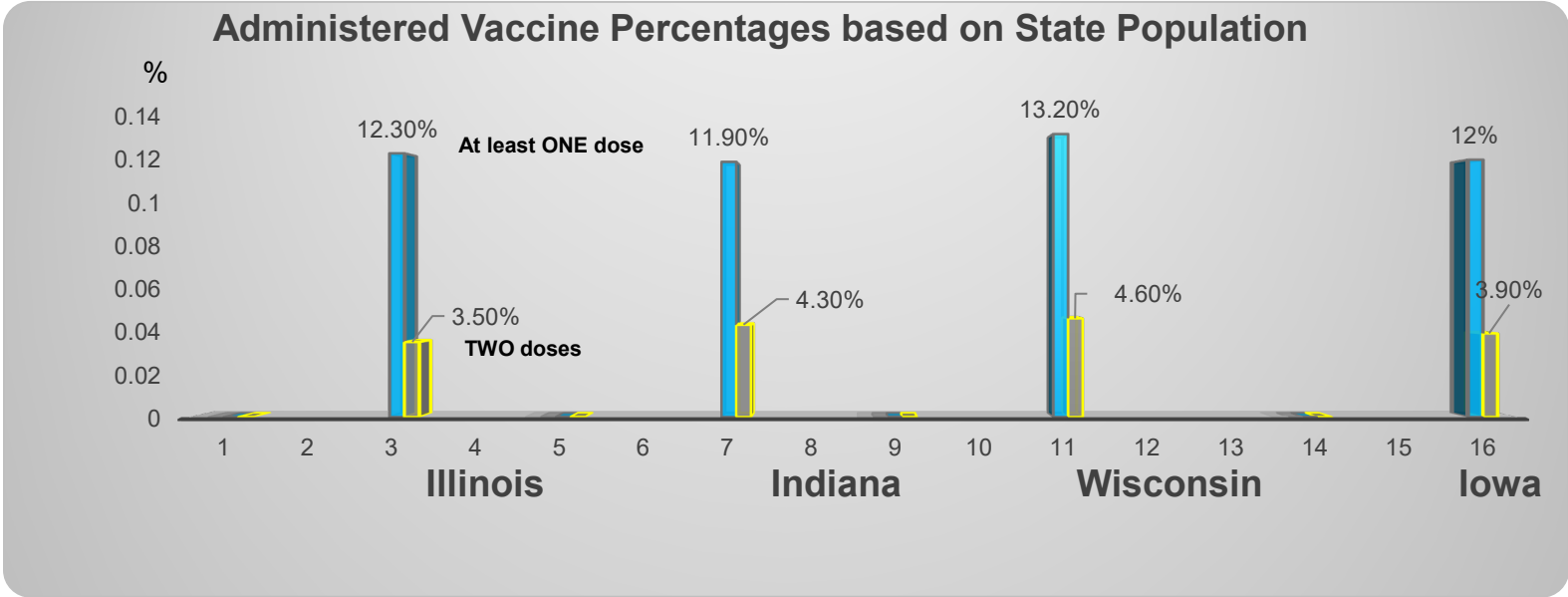

How U.S. States are Administering Covid-19 Vaccines

- ❖ As February 18, a total of 78.69 percent vaccine doses have been distributed in the U.S, that's about 12.43 percent of the U.S. population having received at least one dose of the vaccine. About 4.90 percent of the U.S. population have been fully vaccinated.
- ❖ Some experts estimate that 70 to 90 percent of the population needs to acquire resistance to the coronavirus to reach herd immunity. Estimate to reach that percentage by late fall 2021.

Indiana Doses administered: 1,125,976	Iowa Doses administered: 507,650

- ❖ **Chicago Public Schools'** hybrid learning plan includes 15-student pods to minimize contact with large groups.
- ❖ This will make contact tracing easier.
- ❖ Chicago Public Schools hiring 2,000 new employees to take on Pandemic related duties
