

Recap: WIOA Performance Measures

- > 5 key indicators of success listed in the Act
 - ➤ Employment Rate in 2nd Quarter
 - Employment Rate in 4th Quarter
 - Credential Attainment Rate
 - Median Earnings
 - Skills Gains
- > Exceed, Meet (within 10%) or Fail
- Common measures across all WIOA titles
- Business Service measures coming later





Recap: WIOA Performance Measures Ther of the American Job Center network

Measure	Definition
Employment/ Rate- 2nd Quarter	Percentage of participants who are in unsubsidized employment in the 2nd quarter after exit (Youth: or post secondary education)
Median Earnings	Middle quarterly earnings of program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the the second quarter after exit
Employment/ Rate- 4th Quarter	Percentage of participants who are in unsubsidized employment in the 4th quarter after exit (Youth: or post secondary education)
Credential Attainment w/in 4 Quarters of exit	Percentage of people enrolled in training who achieve a recognized credential by the 4th quarter after exit.
Measurable Skills Gain	Percentage of people who during the program year, are in an education or training program, and show functional gains in skills toward a credential. All In-school Youth are in the measure every program year they are enrolled.

Recap: Program Year



- The WIOA Program Year (PY) is from July 1st to June 30th.
- We are currently in PY 2020 (July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021)
- ➤ PY 2020 Performance is based on participants who exited in prior program years (Jan. 1, 2019-June 30, 2020)
- Exception is Measurable Skills Gain, which is based on the current program year.


What is IPATS?



- ➤ IPATS = Illinois Performance Accountability Transparency System
- Developed by DCEO and housed within Illinois workNet
- Pulls performance and other data from IWDS and presents it in a user-friendly format
- Performance data is updated weekly in both IWDS and IPATS
- Includes WIOA Performance and a real-time data Dashboard

IPATS Demonstration





- ➤ Coming late April/early May:
 - ➤ Adding numerator/denominator flag to the denominator detail
 - ➤ Adding the cohort dates to the "breadcrumb" banner
 - ➤ Adding PY 2021 Performance (pending it being added in IWDS)
- Need to sync up office names in CC, IWDS, and IwN

IPATS Access



- > Agencies will have access to:
 - ➤ Statewide graph & table views
 - >LWIA 7 & 90 graph & table views
 - ➤ Office level individual level data
- ➤ Submit one request sheet per office/agency to the Career Connect Help Desk

- ➤ Updated Reports Instructions has new "WIOA Performance Management Reports" section.
- >Includes:
 - ➤ instructions for running performance in IWDS
 - ➤CC reports for each measure that indicate who is in the denominator and numerator

- DW Eligibility Bug: Cannot complete application if Employment Status = Not Employed; fix is in process
- > DW Eligibility:
 - Use at least the 4-digit NAICS for the dislocation job or it will not trigger "Declining Industry".
 - When selecting a generic industry DETS code, update the employer data with the actual layoff employer.
