

Basic Skills: Reminders



- Basic Skills Assessment Procedure:

- ▶ If your agency is using the CASAS test it must be the <u>CASAS</u> <u>Reading Goals and CASAS Math Goals.</u>
- ➤ It is no longer necessary put in "fake" tests for participants with an Associate's Degree or higher at enrollment. They can use the "College Graduate" option on the State Specific tab.
- For all tests entered, the GLE **must** be entered even though it is not marked with a red (*) on the screen. BSD does not transfer to IWDS correctly without the GLE.

Basic Skills Tool: Reminders



- ➤ The tool is required, regardless of the availability of TABE, CASAS Goals, or ELL test scores.
- Remember, the Basic Skills Screening Tool is required for WIOA applicants, unless they meet one of the exceptions listed below.

Only Exceptions:

- ✓ Has an Associate Degree or higher at WIOA enrollment
- ✓ Has taken a Post-Secondary Entrance/Placement Exam
- ✓ Has a disability that prevents them from completing the form

NEW! Basic Skills Case Note Template



- We created a NEW Basic Skills <u>Case Note Template</u>. It will help you describe all necessary communications are documented in your Case Note. <u>This will be available for you to use April 1, 2021.</u>
- ➤ The Case Note is called "BSD Assessed with Screening Tool" and will include the following in the Case Note description:
 - ✓ the date of the screening,
 - ✓ whether or not the client was determined basic skills deficient, and
 - ✓ if the client is basic skills deficient, the IEP/ISS must include how the individual's deficiency will be addressed.







- Career Coaches and Participants can make decisions that will ensure the participant is <u>suitable</u> for the program and that <u>all barriers to employment</u> and training have been identified.
- ➤ Helps the Career Coach and the participant develop a solid and accurate Individual Employment Plan (IEP) or Individual Service Strategy (ISS).
- We need to create better IEPs and ISSs to minimize audit findings and more importantly to deliver better service!



- Opportunity to get to know the participant for appropriate services and guidance.
- You will have to ask the participant some of these questions directly and others will be answered from paperwork, observation and interactions.
- ➤ You collect this information in some fashion now. The OAS allows you to **document** this information in Career Connect.
- ➤ This will help to drive the participant's IEP/ISS Plan
- ➤ The Objective Assessment Summary and Career Exploration should be completed <u>before</u> IEP/ISS is created.

NEW! OAS Service Code



- Service code for the OAS, 207 Comprehensive and Specialized Assessments (Tests)-Same Day Service:
 - This service is provided to make determinations of participants' skill levels and service needs. It is used to record diagnostic tests and comprehensive and/or specialized assessments of participants barriers to employment, occupational goal(s), along with the occupational knowledge, skills, and abilities associated with that goal, and service needs. This service may include interpreting the results of assessment tools as well as in depth interviewing and evaluation to identify employment barriers and appropriate employment goals. Other assessments may include: a) Prevailing local labor market conditions, including the unemployment rate, local employer skill demands and hiring prerequisites; and b) Transferable skills that the job seeker may possess that would be of interest to other local employers.
- > This only applies to Adult and Dislocated Workers right now.
- The service must be entered <u>before</u> creating the actual OAS
- > The date of the service and the date of the OAS *must* match
- Will be effective April 1, 2021

- 1. Assessment Case Note should be a brief summary of the assessment and needs to include the following:
 - ✓ Work history, current interests, work schedule preferences and wage expectations
 - ✓ Resume and Interviewing skills.
 - ✓ Basic skills deficient & other assessment tools
 - √ Family situation
 - ✓ Address barriers

Things to keep in mind



- ➤ New features available on April 1st
 - ➤ BSD Case Note Template
 - ➤ OAS Service Code 207 Comprehensive and Specialized Assessments (Tests)-Same Day Service: This only applies to Adult and Dislocated Workers right now.
- This procedure has been effective since <u>July 1, 2020.</u> All participants registered in PY 2020 will need to have an OAS completed.
